

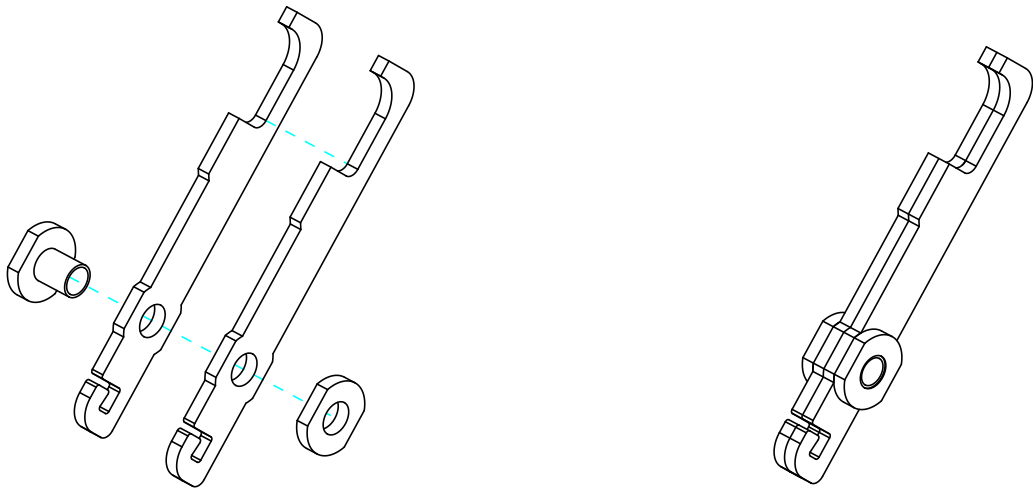

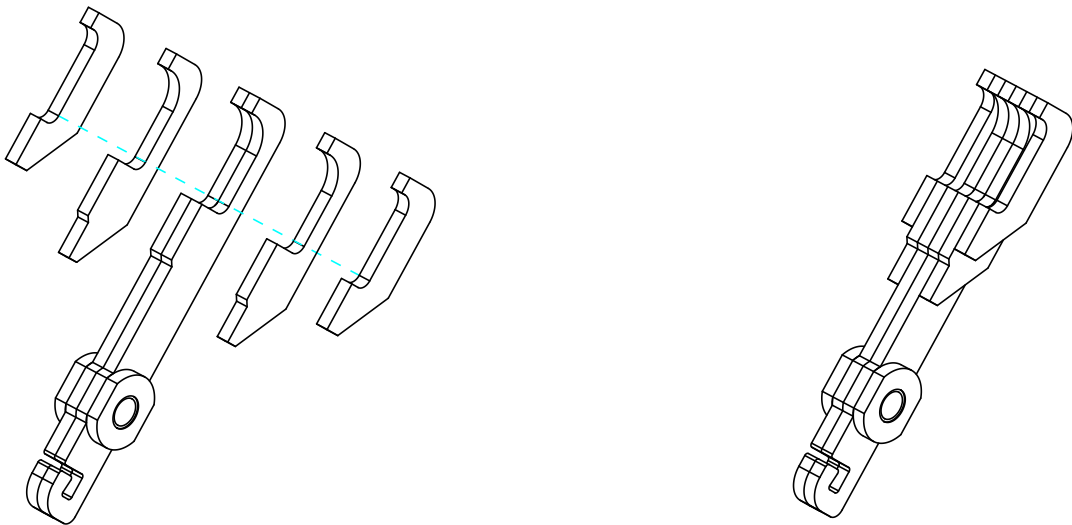
The hollow plastic bushing fits snugly into the arm pieces

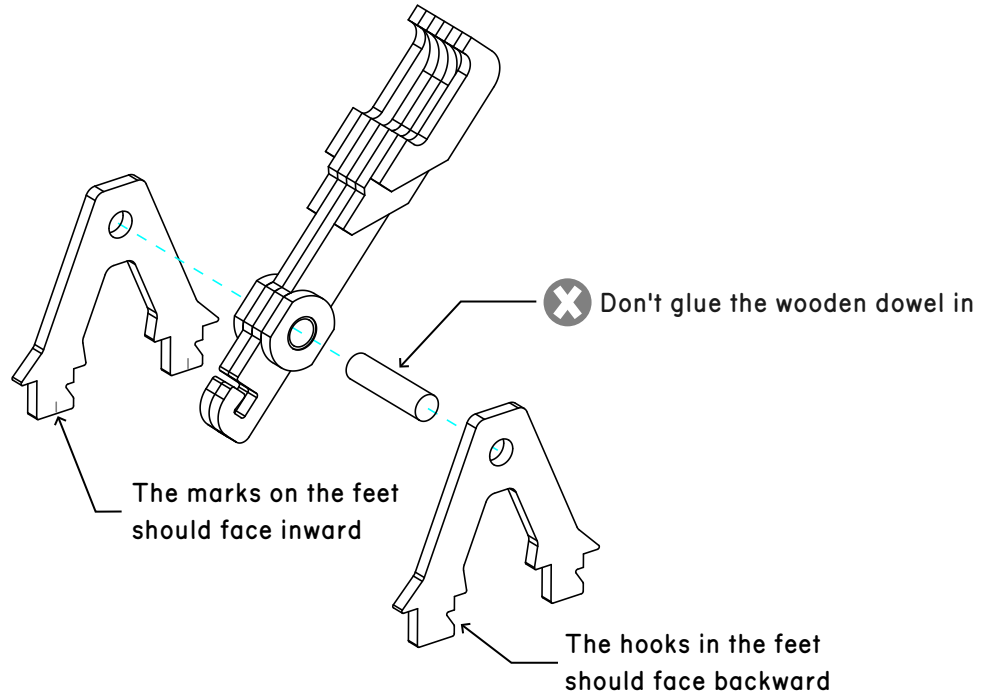
# Catapult

4. To align the pieces of the bucket, press the entire assembly against a flat surface

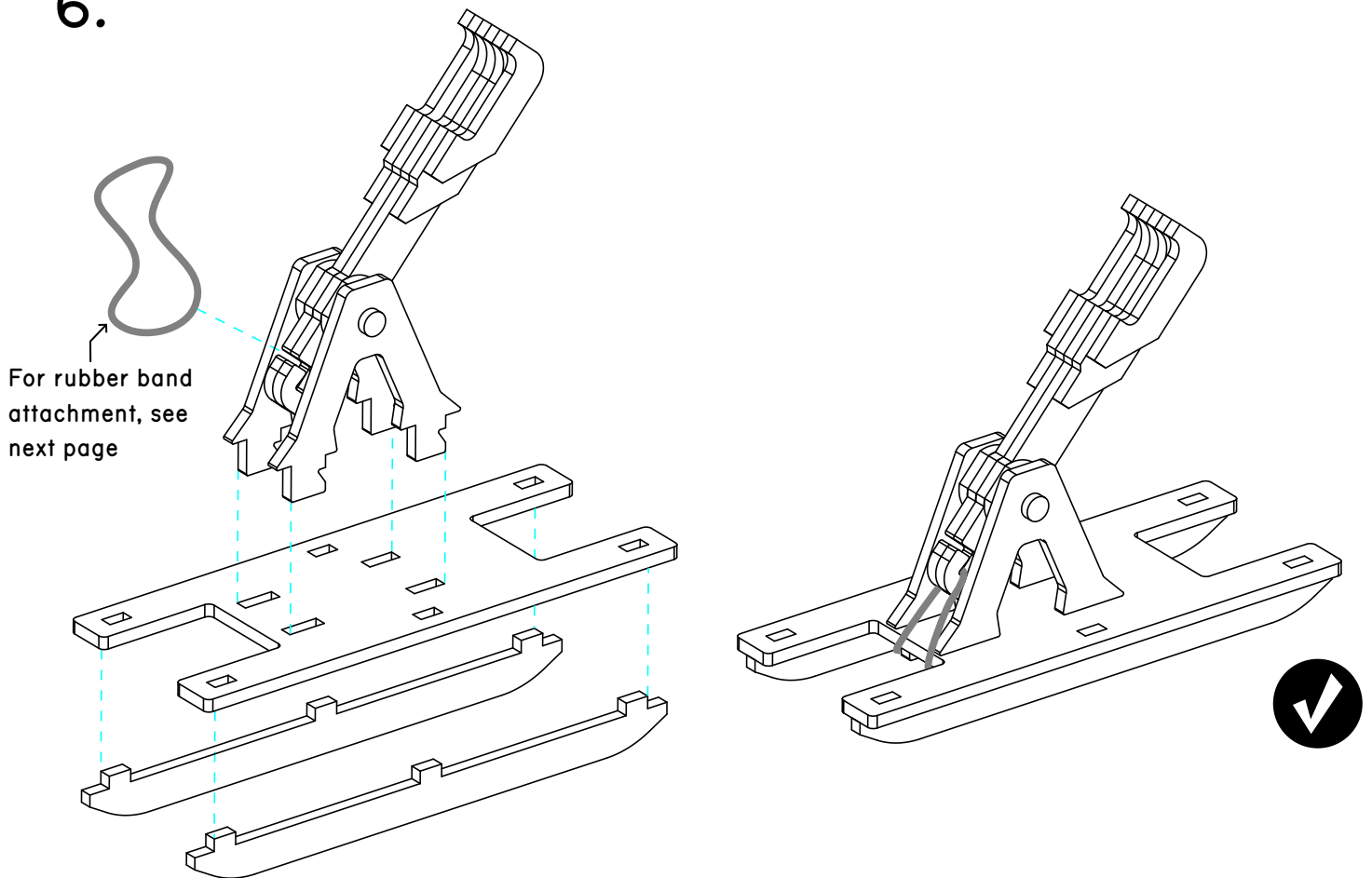

# Catapult - Rubber Band

Find this small, flexible tube with the rubber bands. Push or pull one end of a rubber band through it.



Power:	*	***	**	**
Durability:	***	*	**	****

There are several different ways to attach a rubber band to your catapult. Higher power means longer range. Lower durability means rubber bands will snap more often.
